WHEREAS the Boy Scouts of America was incorporated by Mr. William D. Boyce on February 8, 1910; and

WHEREAS the Boy Scouts of America was founded to promote citizenship, training, personal development and fitness of individuals; and

WHEREAS Elliot Michael Sobel is a resident of the South Anna Magisterial District in Hanover County, Virginia, and a senior at Patrick Henry High School; and

WHEREAS on the 29th day of January, 2014, Elliot Michael Sobel attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest award granted by the Boy Scouts of America; and

WHEREAS to achieve this high honor Elliot Michael Sobel carried out a community project by constructing an outdoor classroom table and bluebird trail on the grounds of his church, St. Anthony's Maronite Catholic Church in Glen Allen, Virginia, that will be used by the Sunday School, Daycare and Parishioners; and
