**ORDINANCE NO. 15-08**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REENACTING ORDINANCE NO. 11-08 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE MAGISTERIAL (ELECTION) DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF HANOVER COUNTY SUPERVISORS AND THE PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES FOR ALL ELECTIONS IN HANOVER COUNTY. THIS PROPOSED ORDINANCE WOULD CHANGE THE POLLING PLACE OF THE FARRINGTON PRECINCT IN THE SOUTH ANNA DISTRICT. THESE CHANGES WOULD BE FIRST EFFECTIVE FOR THE NOVEMBER 2015 ELECTION. NO CHANGES IN DISTRICT BOUNDARIES ARE PROPOSED.**

**ORDINANCE NO. 15-08**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REENACTING ORDINANCE NO. 11-08 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE MAGISTERIAL (ELECTION) DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF HANOVER COUNTY SUPERVISORS AND THE PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES FOR ALL ELECTIONS IN HANOVER COUNTY. THIS PROPOSED ORDINANCE WOULD CHANGE THE POLLING PLACE OF THE FARRINGTON PRECINCT IN THE SOUTH ANNA DISTRICT. THESE CHANGES WOULD BE FIRST EFFECTIVE FOR THE NOVEMBER 2015 ELECTION. NO CHANGES IN DISTRICT BOUNDARIES ARE PROPOSED.**

WHEREAS the Registrar of Hanover County has proposed to the Board of Supervisors the relocation of the polling place of the Farrington Precinct in the South Anna District in the County to an alternate location to address issues pertaining to the number of voters, parking spaces, proximity to precinct and facility functionality, and

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors has determined that the relocation of the polling place as described below will increase the efficiency and ease of voting and will encourage participation in elections by registered voters of the County, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 12-05 adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 25, 2012 amended Ordinance No. 11-08 to relocate the polling places of the Berkley Precinct in the Ashland District from the John M. Gandy Elementary School to the Ashland Fire Station, the Hanover Grove Precinct in the Mechanicsville District from the Stonewall Jackson Middle School to the Mechanicsville Library and the Shady Grove Precinct in the Chickahominy District from the Rural Point Elementary School to the Washington Henry Elementary School, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 14-03 adopted by the Board of Supervisors on June 11, 2014 amended Ordinance 11-08 to relocate the polling places of the Blunts Precinct in the Beaverdam District, the Shady Grove Precinct in the Chickahominy District, the Black Creek Precinct in the Cold Harbor District and the Farrington Precinct in the South Anna District.

WHEREAS this proposed Ordinance No. 15-08 has been properly advertised twice in the Herald-Progress on August 13, 2015 and on August 20, 2015 and copies of the draft Ordinance and related materials were available to the public beginning on August 13, 2015 and the Board held a public hearing on August 26, 2015 for receipt and consideration of public comments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors:

1. That Ordinance No. 11-08 is reenacted and the portion of paragraph 2(g)(3) pertaining to the Farrington Precinct of the South Anna District is amended to establish

the polling place for the Farrington Precinct as the Abner Baptist Church, 15143 Abner Church Road, Glen Allen, Virginia 23005, and that subparagraph shall read in its entirety as follows:

3. Farrington Precinct, the precinct polling place for which shall be the Abner Baptist Church, 15143 Abner Church Road, Glen Allen, Virginia 23059. The precinct boundaries shall be described as:

Commencing at a point that is the intersection of centerlines of Blanton Road (Route 666) and Winston Road (Route 696), thence in a general westerly direction along the centerline of Winston Road to its intersection with the high voltage power line, thence in a northwesterly direction along the high voltage power line to its intersection with the centerline of a private drive, thence in a northeasterly direction along the centerline of the private drive to its intersection with the centerline of West Patrick Henry Road (US-54), thence in a northwesterly direction along the centerline of West Patrick Henry Road to its intersection with the centerline of the South Anna River, thence in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of the South Anna River to its intersection with the centerline of Howards Mill Road (Route 673), thence in a southerly direction along the centerline of Howards Mill Road to its intersection with the centerline of Pouncey Tract Road (US-271), thence in a southerly direction along the centerline of Pouncey Tract Road its convergence with the Hanover-Goochland County Line, thence in a easterly direction along the Hanover-Goochland and Hanover-Henrico County Lines to its confluence with the centerline of Grassy Swamp Creek, thence in a northerly direction along the centerline of Grassy Swamp Creek to its intersection with Winns Church Road (Route 660), thence in a easterly direction along the centerline of Winns Church Road to its intersection with the centerline of Rocky Ridge Road (Route 648), thence in a northwesterly direction along the centerline of Rocky Ridge Road to its intersection with the centerline of Cedar Lane (Route 623), thence in a northwesterly direction along the centerline of Cedar Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Ashland Road, thence in a northeasterly direction along the centerline of Ashland Road to its intersection with the centerline of Greenwood Church Road (Route 657), thence in a northwesterly direction along the centerline of Greenwood Church Road to its intersection with the centerline of Blanton Road (Route 666), thence in a northerly direction along the centerline of Blanton Road to its intersection with the centerline of Winston Road , the point of beginning.

2. That this Ordinance shall be effective for the November 2015 election and subsequent elections.
