## **SECOND AMENDED ORDER OF PUBLICATION**


The object of the above-styled suit is to remove certain graves and have the remains therein reinterred in some suitable repository. The graves are situated on property owned by L. Paul Boshier and JoAnne T. Boshier located at 5284 Mechanicsville Turnpike, on Route 360 in Hanover County, Virginia, and designated as GPIN 8735-47-7089, such property being necessary to the construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance and repair of a certain project; namely, facilities that would replace existing Mechanicsville High School and Bell Creek Middle School.

It appearing by affidavit filed according to law that there may be persons unknown to Plaintiffs who are the relatives or next of kin of deceased persons buried in such graveyard, all of whom are made defendants herein as “Parties Unknown;”


IT IS ORDERED that the said persons made defendants by the general description “Parties Unknown” be hereby notified that on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as they may be heard, Plaintiffs, by counsel, will move the Circuit Court of the County of Hanover, Virginia, in the courtroom of said Court at 7530 County Complex Road, Hanover, Virginia, to enter an order granting to the Plaintiffs authority to move the graves located on the land described in the First Amended Verified Bill in Equity and to remove and to reinter the bodies buried thereon to some suitable location, and any persons objecting to the same should appear and make their objections on the said return date.

It is further ORDERED that an attested copy of this Order be published once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the Mechanicsville-Ashland Local, a newspaper of general circulation in Hanover County.
