



Recreational Fire	Open Air Burn	Commercial Burn
<p>Definition: Any burn on private property that is less than or equal to 3 feet in diameter and no higher than 2 feet; i.e., fire pit, warming fire further than 25 feet from a structure or any combustible material. TRASH cannot be burned!</p> <p>This is allowed at any time of year regardless of residential or agricultural zoning anywhere in the county</p>	<p>Any burn on private property larger than a defined recreational fire. Restrictions below apply:</p>	<p>Any burn on a commercial property or by a contractor on private property requires a permit from the FMO and will be advised to call the FMO during normal business hours.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">   </div>
	12/16-2/15	
	<p>Not zoned R1-R6 & RS outside of the USA can burn any time of day limited to leaves, tree, garden clippings</p>	
	2/16-4/30	
	<p>All properties outside of the USA limited to leaves/tree/garden trimmings between 1600-2400</p>	
	No burning within the USA other than a recreational fire	
	5/1-9/30	
	<p>Not zoned R1-R6 & RS outside of USA limited to leaves/tree/garden trimmings no larger than 5x5x5</p>	
	10/1-10/31	
	<p>Not zoned R1-R6 & RS outside of the USA can burn any time of day limited to leaves, tree, garden clippings</p>	
11/1-12/15		
<p>Not zoned R1-R6 & RS outside of the USA limited to leaves/tree/garden trimmings between 1600-2400</p>
