Absentee FAQs

In-Person Early Voting:

- 1. Where do I go to In- Person Early Vote?**
 - a. The only place to in-person early vote in Hanover County is at our office at the County Complex. Our address is 7497 County Complex Rd. Hanover, VA 23069 and we are located in the Wickham building. If you have any difficulties finding our office, please give us a call at 804-365-6080.

- 2. When does In-Person Early Voting begin for the 2021 November General election?**
 - a. In-person early voting begins on September 17th. Our business hours are 8:30 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday – Friday.

- 3. Are there any weekend hours for the 2021 November General election?**
 - a. We will be open the two Saturdays prior to the election, October 23rd & October 30th, from 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

- 4. What do I need to bring with me to In-Person Early Vote?**
 - a. Since Virginia no longer requires a photo ID, the only thing you will need to bring with you is something with your name and address on it. This can include your driver's license, voter registration card, a utility bill, etc. If you are unsure if your identification is acceptable, please go to <https://www.elections.virginia.gov/media/formswarehouse/voter-id/outreach-materials/documents/Voter-Identification-Chart-Rev-4-28-21.pdf>.

- 5. When is the last day for In-Person Early Voting for the 2021 November General election?**
 - a. October 30th. Our hours that Saturday are 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

- 6. Is curbside voting available at the Early Voting Center?**
 - a. Yes, there are designated curbside voting signs in our parking lot. Pull into one of those spots and one of our Officers of Election in a yellow vest will be out shortly to assist you.
